Imagination Station Out in the Community

TOLEDO, Ohio – On Saturday, October 1, Imagination Station’s CEO Lori Hauser and volunteers who support the science center are going out into the community to speak with Lucas County residents about Issue 21.

- WHAT:** This Saturday will kick off the first full week Imagination Station will be out in the community speaking to voters. They will be going door-to-door visiting residents in the Toledo community to discuss the benefits for voting for Issue 21 on November 8.
- WHEN:** October 1, 10am – Noon

- WHERE:** Volunteers will be knocking on 200 doors along Cheltenham Road, Central Avenue, Hughes Drive, Secor Road and Kenwood Boulevard.
- WHO:** Imagination Station CEO Lori Hauser and volunteers who support Imagination Station and Issue 21.
- WHY:** Imagination Station is requesting a renewal of their current five-year, one-sixth (.17) mill property tax levy. This levy will continue to cost just \$5.13 per year for the owner of a \$100,000 home and is not a new tax. Toledo’s Science Center, is a vital nonprofit organization that is an integral part of Toledo’s economic, educational and social landscape. With hundreds of hands-on exhibits and demonstrations, Imagination Station delivers a multi-sensory experience that’s as fun as it is educational.
